#### PU'UHONUA O HONAUNAU NATIONAL HISTORIC PARK

Also known as "The City of Refuge," Pu`uhonua o Honaunau National Historic Park in South Kona is a site of great importance in the Hawaiian culture. It is one of five national parks on the island its name is in keeping with how Native Hawaiians lived and were governed in ancient times. A self-guided tour through the park will explain the importance of the site and the protection it afforded as an asylum to rule breakers. The park is open daily, 8:15 a.m. to sunset.

#### HAWAI'I VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK

The best way to explore and learn about Hawai`i Island's volcanoes is a visit to the Hawai`i Volcanoes National Park. Established in 1916, Hawai`i Volcanoes National Park encompasses 335,259 acres or about 523 square miles. The park climbs from sea level to ore than 13,000-feet, encompasses two volcanoes – Kīlauea, one of the world's most active volcanoes and Maunaloa, the world's largest subaerial volcano – and six of Earth's climate zones. The park is a place of environments and landscapes that encourage exploration of lava fields, rainforest flora and fauna, lava tubes and craters, coastline meetings of lava rock and ocean, Hawaiian cultural sites, ash-covered deserts, and even alpine tundra.
